Tollgate Primary SEND Curriculum:

The vision for the curriculum underpins our school's four curriculum pathways for children with SEND. Teaching and learning is matched to pedagogy, and this enables progress for very child in line with their Education, Health and Care Plan' goals and aspirations.

We follow a thematic approach, which is skills, and context based and encourages active engagement in learning. The curriculum focuses on developing the key skills of language & communication, cognition, independence, physical development and self-care, all transferrable skills that equip children for the next stages of their learning as well as life beyond the school.

Our curriculum strives to be responsive to each pupil and build on the individual strengths and interests. A thematic plan is in place, for pre-formal ad semi-formal learners, which supports a balance of stimulating contexts for learning through varied learning experiences, themes, therapies, and subjects. Formal and semi-formal challenge pathways enables structured engagement whilst pre-formal and semi-formal explore enables sensory engagement to learn effectively.

Many learners present with spiky profiles and fit in different characteristic pools. We take this opportunity to create bespoke, individual learning pathways by weaving pupils in and out of the different pools to suit their individual needs.
